

SOME DO'S AND DON'TS

- DO keep the Lodge clean and tidy at all times. Vacuum cleaners are provided – remember to empty their dust bags after use
 - DO notify the Secretary of any losses or breakages
 - DO ensure that you use sheets and pillowslips or sleeping bag and pillow slip
 - DO use visitors book with discretion
 - DO operate the equipment with care
 - DO clean your Bedroom and Bathroom frequently and for sure, when you are leaving the Lodge.
 - DO your share of cleaning up the kitchen and other parts of the Lodge
 - DO enter all your calls in the phone record book
 - DO familiarize yourself with the Fire Fighting equipment at the Lodge
 - DO enjoy yourself

- DON'T sit on heaters or cause malicious or thoughtless damage
 - DON'T flush sanitary napkins down the W.C.'s. These items are to be placed in the garbage bags
 - DON'T throw tea leaves or food of any description out the kitchen window
 - DON'T use more than your share of blankets, i.e. 5 blankets and 2 pillows to each bed
 - DON'T wear ski boots in the Lodge other than in the Ski Room and Vestibule
 - DON'T work on skis in other than the Ski Room
 - DON'T removed from the Lodge any of the furniture, utensils, blankets, tools or other equipment
 - DON'T turn off the “dribbling” taps at each end of the Lodge. These are running constantly to prevent water freezing in and causing damage to the pipes
 - DON'T use the fire door as a normal entry and exit door
 - DON'T attempt any repairs to equipment unless you are acting under specific instructions from the Secretary or a Board Member
 - DON'T operate the equipment unnecessarily
 - DON'T be a pig
