

## WIRRUNA LODGE

### ELECTRIC LIGHTING

The Lodge is equipped with many forms of electric lighting and there are two oil lanterns in the Services area for use at time of blackout.

The lanterns must be used with extreme care as they obviously represent a fire hazard.

Each bed is provided with a fluorescent reading lamp and this should be used at night in preference to general bedroom lighting so as to cause minimal disturbance to others who may be sleeping.

The bedroom corridor has suspended light fittings for general illumination but they may be substituted by the low wattage down lights which can be left on all night for convenience of people arriving late. The change over switches for this corridor lighting are the lower pair on the return wall just round the corner from the corridor distribution board near the entrance to Bedroom 3.

The Corridor lighting is 2 way switched as is the lighting of the stairway to the Games Room.

A pair of flood lights is installed at the gable externally of Bedroom 6 to illuminate the walking track from the Car Park to the external door of the Games Room. An iron clad control switch for this flood lighting is on the external weatherboarding at the north western corner of Bedroom 6.

The flood lighting is 2 way switched - externally as mentioned above and at the end of the window in the Bedroom Corridor.

The flood lighting is to be turned off except for obvious essential use.

There are replacement lamps and tubes for the electric light fittings of the Lodge in the Bedroom corridor Store.

Members and their guests are requested to turn off all lights and power outlets when these are not required.
