

PRIVATE TELEPHONE METER

Wirruna Lodge Telephone Number on S.T.D. is (064) 57 5226.

To enable you to pay correctly for your telephone call, whether local or trunk line, a private telephone meter has been installed beside the normal handset.

YOU MUST ENTER ALL CALLS IN THE LODGE'S TELEPHONE RECORD BOOK BESIDE THE TELEPHONE

To make your entry in the Telephone Record Book write down the White/Yellow pointer readings from the Private Telephone Meter both BEFORE and AFTER your call.

The WHITE pointer shows the first two digits, the YELLOW pointer the last two digits: e.g. White on 22 and Yellow on 34, write down 2234.

TO MAKE A CALL:

1. Enter the White/Yellow total as above.
2. Press RED button to zero the Red pointer.
3. Dial your call, prefix 02 for Sydney calls, 03 for Melbourne, etc.
4. Watch the RED pointer. It records your call, each unit will cost you FORTY CENTS.
5. Enter the total of the RED pointer when you hang up, as well as the new total of the White/Yellow pointers.

TELEPHONE CHARGES:

One Local Call = ONE UNIT - Forty Cents.

S.T.D. Calls cost 40 cents per unit.

Sydney and Melbourne charges are as follows:-

- 40 cents for 26 seconds between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m.
- 40 cents for 34 seconds between 6 p.m. and 9 p.m.
- 40 cents for 48 seconds between 10 p.m. and 8 a.m.
- 40 cents for 48 seconds between 1 p.m. and 8 a.m. Sunday.

These times are approximate.

ENTERING THE CALL:

If you do not enter your call properly, the next person making a call will be in trouble. The Board has decided that it is the responsibility of all callers to make sure the previous call is entered OR PAY IT THEMSELVES. (This is because it is much easier for a person in the Lodge to find out who used the phone last that for the Secretary to do so weeks or months later.)

SO BE SURE TO ENTER THE WHITE/YELLOW POINTER READING BEFORE AND AFTER YOUR CALL.
